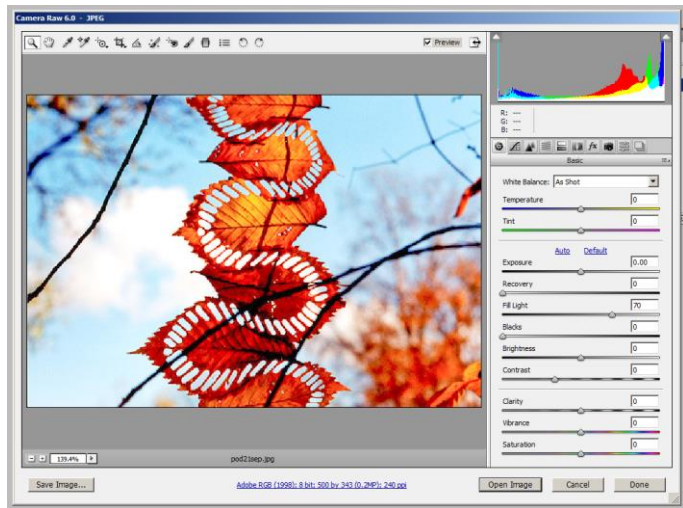


Working With Raw Files

- Make a new folder onto your desktop and name it “Name_Raw_Studio”
- Download the Raw studio images from google drive into that new folder
- Now we have all our Raw files to work with!
- On your desktop you will notice a “Adobe Design” folder, open that up and double click on “**Adobe Bridge**”
- Find the “Name_Raw_Studio” folder in Bridge to begin previewing your images
- Double click on the image you want to open into photoshop
- A Pop-up will appear that looks like this:



- You have the options to make non destructive adjustments to the white balance, exposure, contrast, tonal range, and color ALL before opening up in photoshop
 - After you are done with your adjustments press “Open Image”. This is automatically make your file type from Raw to Tiff.

****Always save your work as a Tiff, do NOT compress your files into Jpegs****
